## 2003 Fun Run Results

### RESULTS & RACE REPORT: LAKE CLASSIC DEC 7 2003

#### Coburg Lake Classic

The 26th running of the Coburg Lake Classic took place on Sunday 7th December. **The Classic is the longest running fun run of its type in Victoria and this year attracted some overseas interest.** The race is organised by the Coburg Harriers Athletics Club and originates from their base at the Harold Stevens Athletics Track.

On a pleasantly cool morning, almost forty people dreaming of glory lined up to attack the undulating five kilometre or ten kilometre course around Coburg Lake.

The main event is the longer ten kilometre race and it is always keenly fought. With a couple of challenging hills, the course is mainly along a bicycle path before it reverts to gravel for six hundred metres to and then from the turnaround point.

Among the competitors was Martin Cryer from the United Kingdom, who is in Australia on a ten week university exchange in Sydney, and had travelled to Melbourne for the event. Lining up alongside him was Darren Smith from Eltham, who has had a successful season including a third placing at the Coburg Harrier's King of the Mountain race, as well as the Olympic Dream, Melbourne and Gold Coast Marathons.

A national champion at this distance, Cryer was very quickly out of the blocks and had already established a commanding lead by the first drink stop at the three kilometre mark. In his wake, Jeremy Grey, Darren Smith and promising Coburg Harrier junior athlete Jay Blake all started well and looked to be fighting it out for the minor placings.

By the turnaround point, Stacey Van Overen was the leading woman and had overtaken Blake to move into overall fourth position. With Martin Cryer establishing a commanding lead, positions stayed as they were for the remainder of the race.

In a time that has not been seen at a Coburg fun run for many a long year, Cryer finished the course in a world class 31 minutes, 48 seconds. Not disgraced were Jeremy Grey in second and Darren Smith close behind in third.
